

SUNDAY MORNING SCHEDULE

10:30 AM

- Children ages 0-2 may go directly to the Nursery.
- Children ages 3 and older join their families for the first portion of the service.

10:40 AM (Approximate)

- Children are called to the front of the Sanctuary for Time for Wonder, a child-friendly story or presentation.
- Children do not have to come forward if they don't want to. You may join your kids at the front of Sanctuary and sit with or near them.

10:45 AM

- On Classroom Sundays, children will be led to their classrooms on the second floor of the Parish House for classes.
- On Creative Sundays, school-aged children ages 5 to 10 come together and participate in a project that involves art, music, dance, or some other hands on activity.

11:40 AM

- RE classes end and a snack is provided in the Mark Pedersen Room (above the parlor).
- Parents should pick up and sign out their child between 11:40 and 11:50 AM.

We seek to create connection, find inspiration and engage the world.

The RE program at FUSIT is a place where children learn and discuss liberal religious values to help them navigate life's challenges. Adults and children together discuss big questions of life and ponder spiritual issues. Children make friends of all ages, learn to care about others, and grow spiritually and emotionally. They are encouraged to take the values they learn on Sunday mornings back to their homes, schools, and playgrounds.

Our hope is to raise children to act beyond the church doors with open eyes and loving hearts. RE is a busy and fun place full of music, art, stories, and dance – and our doors are open to all newcomers.

Children may join our program at any time during the church calendar year. Registration is required and may be done online:

This is a cooperative Religious Exploration program, and we don't charge for our morning RE program. Our RE teachers are volunteers, and most are not education professionals, though all are committed to the spiritual growth of our children. Parents are encouraged to teach in our program after attending FUSIT for one year.
