How to prepare your donations:

1. Please make sure everything is clean and in good condition - worth buying. Polishing and prettying things up will boost sales.
2. Please bring items in bags or boxes sorted and separated for categories listed below and labeled. This will save sorters endless amounts of time. We recycle bags, boxes, and stuffing material.
3. Upon arrival with your donations, you will be directed where to deliver your various items.
4. Make sure that each appliance/electronics/equipment is in working condition. Indicate the age and original price, if known, and include user manuals if available.
